# Gist of Standard Operating Procedures prescribed by Government of India vide their letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

- Students will not be allowed to attend the school if they are from Containment Zone.
- 2. Students will have to maintain physical distancing of 6 feet in the school.
- 3. Students will sit as per seating plan provided by the school.
- 4. Students shall ensure frequent hand washing with soap / sanitizer.

The Revision 1 Exam scheduled on 18 January will be conducted online. The exam scheduled from 20 January to 30 January 2021 will be taken offline (9am to 1pm, as per the Revision 1 timetable shared earlier.)

Please find below the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) that are in place at school, as well as the protocols to be followed by you and your ward. These have been put in effect to ensure the proper conduct of classes, keeping in mind the health, hygiene, and safety of the students and staff.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR HEALTH, HYGIENE AND OTHER SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOLLOWED BY THE SCHOOL:

- Thorough cleaning and disinfecting of all areas, furniture, equipment, stationery, storage places, water tanks, washrooms, laboratories, libraries, etc. on the school campus. Sufficient ventilation in all indoor spaces such as corridors and classrooms.
- 2. Ample hand washing and sanitising facilities in the school.
- 3. Routine and random health checkups using calibrated, contact-less, infrared, digital thermos-scanners.
- 4. Students will be seated in the classroom keeping in line with standard safety practices.
- 5. Posters and signage at appropriate places in the school reminding students about maintaining physical/social distancing such as inside the classroom, libraries, outside washrooms, hand washing stations, drinking water areas, halls, classrooms, entry and exits.
- 6. Availability of a full-time trained nurse in school to take care of the physical health of the students.
- 7. Maintenance and monitoring of cleanliness and hygiene in and around the school premises.
- 8. Alcohol-based hand sanitisers will be placed at prominent places including the reception and school entrance.
- 9. Frequent cleaning and disinfecting of washrooms during the school hours will be ensured.
- 10. Hand washing is mandatory for all students and staff at regular intervals as per the safety protocols. Sufficient physical/social distancing norms will be ensured at this

time. It is recommended that students wash their hands for a minimum of 20 seconds.

# STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR HEALTH, HYGIENE AND OTHER SAFETY PROTOCOLS TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE STUDENTS AND PARENTS:

- 1. Students living in containment zones should not attend physical class. They must inform the school in advance with government issued documentation or other relevant proof.
- 2. Students and their families are advised to stay away from containment zones and suspected Covid-19 hotspot locations.
- 3. Students must bring their own water bottles that can hold a minimum of 1 litre water. This is as per recommended health practices.
- 4. Students should arrive at school wearing a face cover/mask. This must be worn at all times including when in class, during group activities, while at the laboratory, and when reading in the library. Students should not exchange masks with others for their own safety.
- 5. Privately commuting students should ensure safe and hygienic travel at all times. This will ensure their safety and also the safety of their classmates who attend school with them.
- 6. Students should maintain a safe distance between each other at all times.
- 7. Parents should educate the student about personal hygiene, health, and cleanliness as circulated by the relevant health authorities through letters, emails, or any other social media.
- 8. Parents must not send their wards to school if the child or any family member living in the same household suffers from fever/cough/breathlessness etc. Children with underlying medical conditions are to take appropriate precautions as advised by their respective medical practitioners.
- 9. Children and parents with mobile devices are required to download the Arogya Setu application as per instructions from the Hon' Government of India. Staff members are also currently following this protocol.
- 10. Students should not share any materials with each other.
- 11. Students should not share food with each other during snack breaks (only dry snacks).
- 12. Students should sanitise and thoroughly wash their hands before and after snacks, each time they use the washroom.

We are sure that with your support, we will be able to safely conduct physical classes in an efficient manner. Our school has taken all standard measures and precautions to keep your ward healthy, and we urge you to follow the same. It has been over 9 months since your wards have met their friends and come to school. At the same time, they must take care not to come into contact with other students. If they stay vigilant and careful for a

short while more, it will ensure everyone's safety. Kindly advise your ward about recommended health practices (washing their hands, refraining from touching their face unnecessarily). We seek your cooperation in this regard.
